



ADVANCED DIRECTIVE POLICY

According to the Idaho Attorney General, “Idaho law provides for individuals to ensure that their wishes about their healthcare are carried out in the event they become incapacitated and are not able to speak for themselves.”*

Due to the elective nature of procedures done at our facility, any existing Advanced Directives will not be followed while you are a patient at this Surgery Center. If you have Advanced Directives, you can provide them at the time of service, however in the event of a medical emergency appropriate care will be provided and transfer arrangements will be made. We will forward your Advanced Directives with your medical records should you be transferred to a hospital.
